

IMPACT

Increased recognition of the need for leadership alignment, as 33% of healthcare leaders identified lack of executive support as the biggest barrier to IPC success.

The added data point (92% of respondents agreed that poor infection prevention practices affect communities long-term) strengthens the argument for system-level thinking and leadership alignment.
